Chablis Grand Cru 'Reserve de l'Obédience' 2017, Domaine Laroche, Burgundy, France

First, there is the typical floral character of Blanchots, on both the nose and the palate, and then an intense minerality appears on a layer of ripe white fruit. It develops and offers a remarkable aroma complexity, with a superb finish. Harmonious after 4 to 5 years. Réserve de l'Obédience shows all its potential after 10 to 12 years.

Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru 'Les Caillerets' 2018, Domaine Jean-Noël Gagnard, Burgundy, France

The 'Les Caillerets' is a wine of superb class and poise with a distinctive saline minerality. Elegant and well-structured with layers of citrus and apricot fruit, it promises great ageing potential. V

Barolo 'Bricco delle Viole' 2017, G.D. Vajra, Piemonte, Italy

Brilliant ruby red in colour. On the nose, there is an incredible bouquet of purple flowers, raspberries and redcurrants, which interlace with hints of rose, rhubarb, toffee apple and incense. As the wine opens, layers of marasca cherries, white truffle, lavender and anise fill the nose. Expressive yet balanced on the palate, red fruit flavours, subtle minerality and refined tannins carry through onto the long finish. V

Saint-Julien 2011, Château Léoville Poyferré, Bordeaux, France

The 2011 vintage of Château Léoville Poyferré displays an intense garnet color and purple reflections. The wine remains bright and limpid, a sign that it continues to flourish. Starting to show some evolution, expressive notes of black fruit, oak and spice meld together in this beautiful 2011 vintage, intensifying with light aeration. This Saint-Julien is fine and elegant with a juicy tannic structure. Aromas of black fruit and spices dominate, revealing notes of liquorice on the persistent finish.

'Camarcanda' Cabernet Sauvignon/Cabernet Franc 2015, Ca' Marcanda, Tuscany, Italy

This wine has a complex nose with aromas of ripe red fruits and balsamic notes, and hints of fresh violets and strawberries. On the palate, flavours of blackberry, blueberry, liquorice and blood orange persist through the lengthy finish.

Charmes-Chambertin Grand Cru 2013, Domaine David Duband, Burgundy, France

Dress cherry burlat brilliant. A nose of red berries and blacks with an aromatic dynamics of pepper. A fine touch of sandalwood. The mouth is rich and fat with present and very slightly aggressive tannins which expect a beautiful potential of guard.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape Rouge 1983, Château de Beaucastel, Southern Rhône, France

This wine is deep ruby red in colour, with purple highlights. On the nose, there are aromas of ripe cherry, blackcurrant, figs, lavender and spicy notes. On the palate, it is well-balanced with round, ripe tannins. A powerful wine which will continue to improve with age.
